

## **Edible Seder Place Cards**

## Materials:

Matzah
Pareve chocolate, about 8 oz. (either chips or bar)
Cookie sheet covered with wax paper or baker's parchment

## Directions:

- Break or carefully divide the matzah into pieces about 3" wide.
- Melt the chocolate over a double boiler or in the microwave.
- Dip one end of the matzah about 1" into the chocolate. Place on a cookie sheet covered with wax paper. Do this with all the pieces.
- Using the end of a spoon, drizzle a guest's name on each piece.
- Place the cookie sheet in the refrigerator or freezer to harden the chocolate.
- When setting the table, cut the wax paper around each "place card" and put them on the table. (This will protect your table cover.)

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
