And may it be the will before the One who dwells in the heavens to plantgood counsel in the hearts of all the leaders of the country, that they mayknow how to conduct the nation's war with understanding, awareness andwisdom, and to bring upon our enemies the words of Scripture, For theirday of disaster is upon them, the hour of their doom.[6]
