



Edible Seder Place Cards

Materials:

Matzah

Pareve chocolate, about 8 oz. (either chips or bar)

Cookie sheet covered with wax paper or baker's parchment

Directions:

- *Break or carefully divide the matzah into pieces about 3" wide.*
- *Melt the chocolate over a double boiler or in the microwave.*
- *Dip one end of the matzah about 1" into the chocolate. Place on a cookie sheet covered with wax paper. Do this with all the pieces.*
- *Using the end of a spoon, drizzle a guest's name on each piece.*
- *Place the cookie sheet in the refrigerator or freezer to harden the chocolate.*
- *When setting the table, cut the wax paper around each "place card" and put them on the table. (This will protect your table cover.)*
