

# AFGHAN STITCH CROCHET *HALLAH* COVER CH # 190

Materials:

- 2 large balls of bedspread thread
- 2 skeins of varying shades of golden brown DMC embroidery thread (6 strand) for the *hallah*
- 2 skeins of 2 shades of metallic gold DMC embroidery thread for the candlesticks
- 1 skein of DMC embroidery thread, any color, for the letters
- 2 skeins of DMC embroidery thread of coordinated colors for the flowers in the letters
- 1 skein of white DMC embroidery thread for the candles
- small amounts of blue, grey and green DMC embroidery thread for the Star of David, the outline of the candles and leaves

crochet hook

## DIRECTIONS:

1. Row 1: Chain 105 stitches.
2. Row 2 - 90 Work afghan stitch.
3. When 90 rows are completed, single crochet around the piece on all four sides, increasing in each corner. Repeat for a total of 4 rows.
4. Cut 4" strands of thread for the fringes.
5. Pull a fringe through each single crochet stitch on all four sides. Increase the fringes in each corner (3 fringes per corner).
6. Cross stitch the pattern onto the cover, following the graph of the pattern. The pattern can also be done on Aida cloth.
