

Shabbat and Yom Tov Wooden Candle Holder

This wooden candle holder is a simple project that my daughter made in shop at school. The basic material is a wooden dowel or 1½" by 1½" piece of wood 50" long. This is then cut in the proper lengths and the candle holder is either glued or nailed together.

The interesting addition to this project is the center dowel, which allows the different branches to swivel. This is done by drilling a hole from the bottom through three of the pieces and halfway through the fourth, and then inserting a long nail or dowel.

The holes for the candles are drilled on top to accommodate whatever size candle you wish to use.
