God makes peace in God's heights. When the constellations ascend, each one thinks, "I will ascend first," and because one does not see what is before them, one is not envious. So I heard. [Tanchuma Buber ad loc.] Another explanation: God makes peace in God's heights—Fire and water are mixed, and the water does not extinguish the fire; I did not hear this.

Although God has delegated certain powers to the innumerable forces of Nature, they remain subject to God's overall charge and control, thus ensuring that they operate in harmony.

Steinsaltz on Job 25:2

Dominion and fear are with God. God has supreme authority and power; therefore, God casts God's awe upon all. **God** also **makes peace in God's heights.**
