

Convert a Torah Fund Pin into a Tallit Clip

Create a Meaningful Keepsake from Your Torah Fund Pins

These instructions will work with most Torah Fund pins.

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Please Note: This project uses strong magnets. Handle with care and keep magnets away from electronic devices and anyone with a pacemaker or other implanted medical device.

Supplies

The following items are available from Amazon unless otherwise noted.

1. **Two (2) Metal ID Badge Clips** (approximately 1.2")

2. **Two (2) Round Adhesive Magnets** (approximately 0.67")

3. **Two (2) Non-Magnetized Iron/Nickel Steel Discs** (approximately 0.98") to attach to the badge clips

(Supplies Not pictured- available at most craft or discount stores)

4. **E6000 Glue** (or Gorilla Glue)
5. **Mini Flush Cutters or Diagonal Wire Cutting Pliers**
6. **Beadalon® 19-Strand Stainless Steel Beading Wire** or similar brand (approximately 10" long)

8. **Two (2) 2 x 2 Crimp Beads** <https://a.co/d/0j6XXDNy>
9. **Approximately 20 assorted 6 mm beads** (in your choice of colors)



Preparing the Badge Clips and Torah Fun Pins

1. **Remove the Legacy Loop** - Using flush cutters, carefully clip off the loop from the back of the Torah Fund pin. **Wear protective safety glasses while cutting.**
2. **Attach the Steel Discs** -Using E6000, glue one non-magnetized steel disc to each metal ID badge clip on the side with the attachment hole. Press firmly and allow the adhesive to cure overnight. **Do not cover over the hole.**
3. **Attach the Magnet to the Torah Fund Pin** – Using E6000, put a small amount on the back of the pin. Press the magnet into the glue with the wording side down. Press firmly and allow the adhesive to cure overnight. (A clothes pin is helpful to hold it tight) **You can also purchase a premade magnet to slip onto the pin and connect the pin to the badge clip (see below).



Stringing the Beads (youtube has great beading videos if you need visual instructions)

1. Attach the First Clip

- Slide one crimp bead onto the beading wire.
- Feed the wire through the hole in one badge clip.
- Pass the wire back through the crimp bead.
- Pull snug and flatten the crimp bead with flat-nose pliers or crimp tool to secure it.

2. Add Your Beads

- String your 6 mm beads in the pattern of your choice.
- Make the strand any length you prefer.
- A finished length of approximately **7½ inches** works well for most tallit clips.

3. Attach the Second Clip

- Slide on the second crimp bead.
- Feed the wire through the hole in the second badge clip.
- Pass the wire back through the crimp bead.
- Pull the wire snug and crimp securely with flat-nose pliers or crimp tool to secure it.



Optional

Customize your tallit clip by creating a bead pattern that reflects your personal style or meaningful colors. Each clip becomes a unique keepsake and a beautiful way to show your support of Torah Fund. Using magnets allows you to change out the pin based on your mood.

Enjoy wearing your beautiful new magnetic tallit clip!
