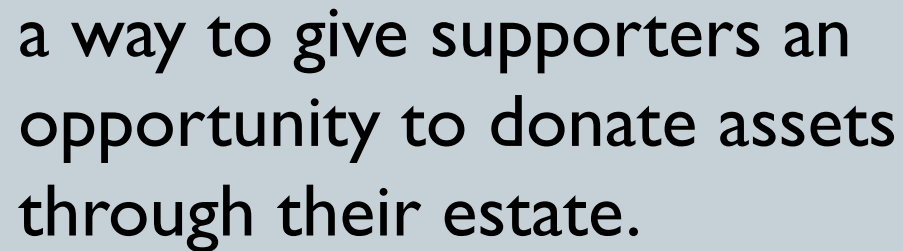

The Legacy Gift is NOT about death

The Legacy Gift offers the opportunity to do something significant during the donor's lifetime

Legacy Giving Myths



- **Legacy gifts are ONLY given by the wealthy**
 - Any amount is appreciated. There is no minimum gift required.
- **Legacy gifts = taking away inheritance**
 - The majority of an estate is left to family members
 - Legacy commitments typically represent only a percentage of an estate
- **No will = no legacy gift**
 - Legacy gifts can be made through a will or by adding Torah Fund as a beneficiary of a retirement plan (IRA), life insurance policy or CD

How To Make A Bequest

- Make a bequest in your will
- Name Torah Fund as a beneficiary of a life insurance policy
- Name Torah Fund a beneficiary of a retirement plan (IRA)
- Name Torah Fund as the final beneficiary in a trust under your will
- Name Torah Fund as a beneficiary of a Certificate of Deposit (CD)

Consult your professional advisor to determine which method of giving is best for you.

- Complete and submit the Bequest Confirmation
- Wear your Legacy Society charm with your Torah Fund pin
- You will be recognized as part of the Legacy Society in Torah Fund publicity (with your permission)
